**Re: Authorization to Place Facilities into Service**

Dear Ms. Connolly:

I grant your September 17, 2018 request, as supplemented on September 28, 2018, for NEXUS Gas Transmission, LLC (NEXUS) to place into service the greenfield mainline pipeline, Hanoverton Compressor Station, and four metering and regulating facilities of the NEXUS Gas Transmission Project, in Ohio and Michigan. Your request is in compliance with environmental condition 11 of the Commission's August 25, 2017 *Order Issuing Certificates and Granting Abandonment* (Order) issued in the above referenced docket. Based on NEXUS's recent construction status reports and our third-party compliance monitor field inspections, we find that NEXUS has adequately stabilized the areas disturbed by construction and that restoration is now proceeding satisfactorily. In addition, we note that NEXUS commitments to employ the necessary crews to complete the remaining clean-up and restoration work as close to October 31, 2018 as possible.

I remind you that NEXUS must comply with all applicable terms and conditions of the Commission's Order. Commission staff and the compliance monitors will continue to monitor the progress of restoration for compliance with all pertinent environmental requirements.
